Below are the themes that each table reported out at the conclusion of the Timeline Event. These are general overview responses to many small groups' general experience of the event.

- Dynamic leadership has made a difference at EACRC; it is important to Eastern members.
- God's faithfulness is evident in our church's history, through ups and downs of church life.
- Maintaining relationships while on the cutting edge of divisive issues.
- We are a community united in prayer through the Holy Spirit.
- Being called to being an open, inclusive, justice-oriented community
 - "When we are inclusive, we grow; when we are exclusive, we don't grow"
 - Inclusion and listening with respect, while continuing to worship together
 - Inclusion is difficult and desired
 - Desiring inclusion and diversity is our strength and future (teen table)
- Doing what's right because of our love for others
- Courage is evident in our history of affirming and including all people; we are a courageous community.
- We're known for tackling issues and confronting them.
- Caring for each other: when it works it's good; when it doesn't, it's bad and hard.
- Change is a source of joy, sorrow, and hope.
- The fear of pain will not keep us from action.
- Active, welcoming community, welcoming of Latinx community - we're practicing the love of Christ, while also recognizing that it takes practice.

Church Innovations Facilitators' observations include the following thoughts:

- trust in leadership is building for our congregation
- this congregation is willing to trade things and allows the 'letting go' of other things
- this congregation is willing to admit conflict, while demonstrating resilience
